# TWO BOARDS WITH ALFREDO

## Short interview regarding the first 20 boards

Last night I called Alfredo, wondering if everything was good during the tournament. Then I remembered that the director is the legendary Antonio Riccardi and therefore I didn't have to worry.

I took a quick check at the results and I immediately went to the point: "Come on Alfredo, tell me a few hands where I would surely get it all wrong".

Alfredo: "One of the most interesting hand about yesterday was the n.4. First position, everybody vulnerable you hold:

♠ Q1082  
♥ 2  
♦ KQJ10932  
♣ 2

### What's your call?

Three players decided to open this hand 3♦, one player 1♦ and in four tables we saw pass. I had only two options but me and Agustin Madala both claimed that we would have opened 4♦. Well this is the beauty of our game: a lot of different opinions only at the first round of bidding. It's incredible imagine how many problems you can discover at the end of the bidding and the 13 cards played: million different solutions. That is probably the reason why who play this game love this game!

Another interesting hand was the 3NT played on board 14. Let's suppose the opening lead is the ♥4 ..interesting problem for south at the first trick is to play the Queen with AQx, just to preserve the communications and to do not show the honor split situation to the declarer. Now declarer must win with the King and play spade to the 10 and small club from dummy. There is a small percentage to play the Queen, it is 7-8 times higher then playing for Kx offside... but, if there is a day where you want to go against statistics, it is the right one! Why? Because how many players are able to duck the club with the King knowing that its partner can have four winners hearts tricks?" Come on, nobody." Enjoy you all, I will try to call Alfredo tonight too.
